Purchase Short-Term Access Pay per Article:

If your institution does not maintain a subscription to a particular SAGE journal, single articles can be purchased online with access to the article available for a 24-hour period.

1. Click on the article's PDF or Full-Text (HTML) link. At the top of the next screen, a message will appear that states, "This item requires a subscription to [Journal Name]" (example shown at right).

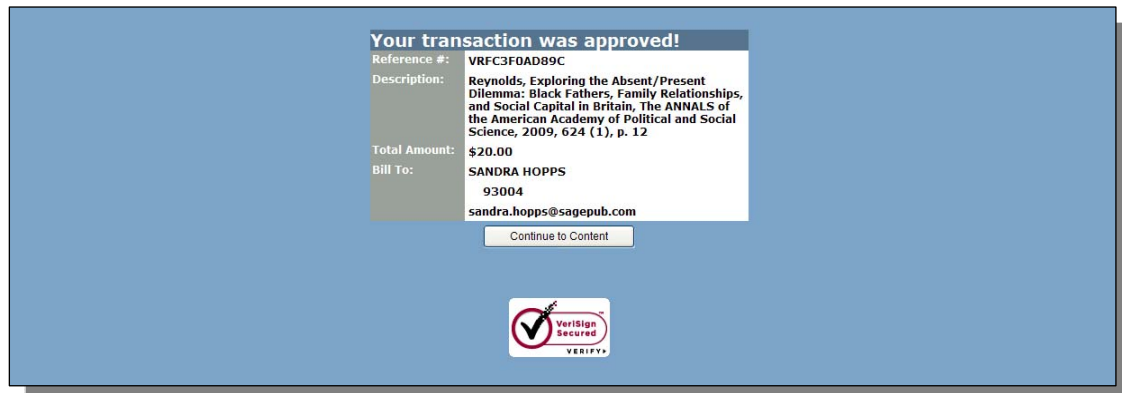

7. The next screen confirms your purchase (example shown below). You will also receive an automated email confirmation from <<sagepuborders@highwire.stanford.edu>> containing your transaction information (please retain this message for your records—this is the only receipt you will receive for the purchase). On the confirmation screen, click the “Continue to Content” link to open the full-text article. Please allow 5-10 seconds for the article PDF to open (time may vary depending on your internet connection speed and size of article). You may click the “Begin Automatic Download” link if the article does not open within this timeframe.



Purchase Short-Term Access Regain Access:

Upon completing your purchase, you will have unlimited access to your article for one day (24 hours). If you close your browser and then return to your article, you should regain immediate access to the content as you will be authenticated by your browser cookies. However, if you lose access your article or need to access your article on a different computer than you used to purchase the article, follow these instructions:

1. Follow step 1 from above and under “Purchase Short Term Access” click on the “Regain Access” link. You will need to enter the Reference # (Transaction ID) (example shown below) and click the “Regain Access” button. (If you do not have your Transaction ID available, you can enter the email address used to make your purchase and another email will be sent to you containing a link to regain access to your article).

2. The next screen will contain a link to your article (example shown below). Simply click on the hyperlinked article title and the full text article will open.
