



Write Dance

Become a Write Dance Trainer!

'scrimbling', 'write-drawing', writing!

The course *'Become a Write Dance Trainer'* comprises of three weekends. During these three weekends you will get to know Write Dance inside out. All delegates will thoroughly explore the music, 'the write-drawings' and writing exercises in Write Dance.

Course aim: To find the 'Write Dance swing and style', for both children and delegates.

Work based tasks: Delegates will be required to work with a group of children, or with individuals, to apply the write dance method between the weekend sessions and provide feedback in the form of a 'Report'.

Reports and children's write dance work will be discussed in detail within the supportive group of delegates.

Certificate of attendance: At the final session all successful delegates will receive a certificate entitled **'Write Dance Specialist'**. Specialists can work in their own schools or settings; they can give workshops to teachers or therapists, and add Write Dance to their therapeutic skills.

The maximum number of delegates will be 20.
